Claire Phillips qualified as a veterinary surgeon with a BVM&S degree from the University of Edinburgh and became a member of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons in 1984. She spent 7 years in mixed and small animal general veterinary practice in Hertfordshire, Yorkshire and the West of Scotland before returning to Edinburgh where she gained her PhD in 1995. After a further period in general practice she was appointed Lecturer in Veterinary Microbiology at Edinburgh in 1999. In 2006 she was appointed Veterinary Clinical Lecturer in Small Animal Practice and promoted to Senior Lecturer in 2009. She is a member of the

Veterinary Medical Education Division at the Vet School and is a Fellow of the Higher Education Academy and was Director of Veterinary Admissions 2009-2014.

She has been Deputy Director of Veterinary Teaching since 2010, Director of Quality at the Vet School since 2014 and in June 2018 was appointed Dean of Quality for the College of Medicine and Veterinary Medicine..
