



Law Academic Entry Requirements

This advice sheet aims to inform you about the academic entry requirements to study the LLB Law at different universities across Scotland.

We encourage you to research the universities yourself. Look into how they teach Law as they all deliver the course in different ways, some which may suit you and others which may not. This information will inform which universities you may wish to apply to and in turn the entry requirements you'll need to cover.

Please note the following about the entry requirements listed below*:

1. These are MINIMUM requirements needed to enter the selection process and exceeding these will significantly increase the chances of your application being successful.
2. These requirements are to be achieved in one sitting (S5) and if it is over two sitting (S5 & S6) they usually increase by a grade or an extra Higher. For example, BBBB becomes ABBB or BBBB. This varies between universities so you should check with the admissions department of each university you are applying to.
3. We have focused on the Higher requirements and advise you to check directly with the universities for any Standard Grade requirements. These may be General Entry Requirements for that University or specific to their Law course.
