



Who can get involved?


ACES provides encouragement and advice for students who are often under-represented in universities. You may attend a priority school, and/or be first in your family to go to university; but more importantly you will be passionate about art and design and want to find out more about the courses and careers involved.

How will I know if I'm eligible?

ACES works with priority schools within your region – your art teacher will have more details on which schools are included. If you're not a student at one of these schools, don't worry, as you may still be eligible to be involved. If you'd like to check your eligibility, please contact your local 'ACES' project officer.
