Notes and definitions

It includes all students with the exception of those students who withdrew from the University within 5-weeks of Semester 1 commencing. This filter is used as a means of approximating the student population, as defined by the Scottish Funding Council.

3. Domicile on entry groupings refers to the students area of permanent residence to the University. This information is declared by the student at matriculation on entry to the first year of their programme of study. Where figures are less than 5 these have been rounded up for data protection.
