

## Bradley Stevens



Bradley is currently President of the Edinburgh University Students' Association for 2026-2027, elected to represent the voices of over 49,000 students across the University. Having completed his Undergraduate Degree in Politics in May 2026, Bradley's research has focused on issues of political representation, including gender, equality, and the environment.

As a sabbatical officer, Bradley's focus includes embedding and sustaining a student voice-oriented culture, in empowering students to be active agents of their journey at Edinburgh. This includes enhancing deliberative mechanisms of dialogue between the university's wide-ranging groups, on topics including financial literacy, as well as campus accessibility and affordability.

During his studies, Bradley has volunteered in local radio, including his position as Head of Music at FreshAir, providing central coverage at Pleasance for the Edinburgh Festivals, as well as raising funds for children's hospital radio charity, Radio Lollipop. Prior to his time at Edinburgh, Bradley was Student Voice Strategy Officer for the Better Futures Multi-Academy Trust, where he prioritised adapted and robust student feedback provisions during the COVID-19 pandemic.

As President, Bradley is a member of multiple committees to amplify the voice of students, including Senate and University Executive in addition to those listed below.
